

Customer Subgroup Meetings Next Step in Act 129 Collaborative Process

Duquesne Light hosted the first in a series of collaborative exchange meetings April 3 at the DoubleTree Hotel in downtown Pittsburgh as the company develops its plans and programs to comply with Act 129, new state legislation intended to help residents and businesses save money by reducing electric consumption

The goal of the April 3 exchange was to provide an overview of Act 129 and to establish the communications channels that will create the mixture of energy efficiency and demand-reduction programs that will best match the needs of our customers while meeting the targets contained in the legislation. Customer and stakeholder response to the initial meeting has gotten the process off to a promising start. Residential, commercial/governmental, industrial and demand-response subgroups were formed to provide input in the planning and development of the company's overall program.

As the next step in the process, subgroup meetings will be held in the second floor auditorium at our headquarters building at 411 7th Ave. in downtown Pittsburgh.
