DUQUESNE LIGHT'S LOW-INCOME CUSTOMERS CAN "STAY WARM" THIS WINTER *Program Provides Customers Free Home Energy Audits*

PITTSBURGH — Duquesne Light's low-income customers are being offered more help this winter, with the rollout of the company's Stay Warm program. Effective January 14, 2009, the program provides help with energy conservation for customers whose income falls between 150 and 250 percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

The Stay Warm program affords customers the opportunity to have a free energy audit performed at their home or apartment. This audit, performed by Conservation Consultants, Inc., includes a walk-through audit of the customer's home, a digital wattage measurement of high-use appliances, a bill breakdown of electricity consumption, free compact fluorescent light bulbs and many helpful tips concerning appliance use and maintenance.
